Community College of Philadelphia Career and Advanced Technology Center

In November, GREYHAWK commenced project and construction management for a new \$32.4 million training hub for Community College of Philadelphia. The 75,000-square-foot Career and Advanced Technology Center will house state-of-the-art automotive, advanced manufacturing, and high-tech healthcare programs to provide students with pathways to high-demand careers while developing pipelines of technical talent for area businesses. The project was designed by SCHRADERGROUP Architecture + Design. Community College of Philadelphia is the largest public institution of higher education in Philadelphia and the sixth largest in Pennsylvania.

Energy Rebates Secured for Willingboro School District

In late 2019, GREYHAWK secured over \$289,000 in energy rebates for the Willingboro, N.J., school district. Fritz Marth named a shareholder


